Ernest Gross Dead at Egg Harbor
Special to The Inquirer.
EGG HARBOR CITY, N. J., Oct. 5.—Ernest Gross, a prominent resident of this city, died suddenly today of apoplexy. Mr. Gross was at one time prominently known in Philadelphia, where for many years he was engaged in the butcher business. Some fifteen years ago he retired and made this city his home. He was an uncle to Peter Schemm, the Philadelphia brewer. He was a member of the Herman Lodge, F. and A. M., and St. Mary's Commandery of Philadelphia. He was 79 years of age.
