MAR.782 William Peach House 21Gingerbread Hill, Marblehead

MA 1691

This house is a first period frame salt box with central chimney. It is unusual in that it has a central entrance with three windows across the front. Most houses of this type remaining in town are larger with five windows across the front. There is a shed roof in the back. There is no clear indication that the shed is a late addition. The house faces south. There are hand-hewn, rough, vertical beams, wide, worn floorboards, and wooden pegs throughout.
