NICHOLSON, THOMAS. Capt. Simeon Brown's co., Col. Jacob Gerrish's regt. of guards; service between April 2, 1778, and July 3, 1778, 2 mos. 25 days. Roll dated Camp Winter Hill.	
NICHOLSON, THOMAS. List of men raised in Essex Co. for the term of 9 months from the time of their arrival at Fishkill, returned as mustered by Henry Rutgers, Jr., Deputy Muster Master, dated Fishkill, Aug. 1, 1778; engaged for <u>town of Marblehead</u> ; arrived at Fishkill July 7, 1778.	
NICHOLSON, THOMAS. Petition dated Boston, July 21, 1780, signed by Martin Brimmer, of Boston, asking that said Nicholson be commissioned as commander of the ship "Union" (privateer); ordered in Council July 21, 1780, that a commission be issued.

The note below was included in the probate of mariner, Robert Nicholson, whose estate was deemed insolvent.

When the note was written, Captain Thomas Nicholson had left two sons, Robert, without heirs, deceased, and Thomas, who was to inherit his brother's share. My guess is that the probate dated in 1795 was for the deceased brother, Robert, son of Thomas.

This may certify all whom it may concern, that Capt. Thomas Nicholson late of Marblehead in the County of Essex married Decesd. did possessed of certain Estate lying in said Marblehead, & that the Decesd. left two sons, namely Robt. Nicholson & Thomas Nicholson, and the said Robert Nicholson dying without issue, has left his Brother the s^r Thomas Nicholson sole heir to the Estate left by their Father as he will fully make appear, And it is the desire & request of the said Thomas Nicholson the Subscriber, That Administration on the said Estate be given by the Judge of Probate in said County, to Wm. J. - hua Preside of S. Marblehead Gentleman

Dated at Marblehead the 3rd day of July A.D. 1795
