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IMMIGRANTS TO AMERICA BEFORE 1750

BARTLETT, Robert (b. Frampton, Co. Dorset, Eng., Feb. 4, 1638-will made Feb. 2, 1714, proved June 27, 1717), son of William (d. 1657), and Edith Bartlett, of Frampton; and bro. of John (qv), of Marblehead, Mass., and Faithful (qv), of Boston, Mass.; came from Frampton, Eng.; resident of Mass., 1666; yeoman and fisherman; settled at Marblehead, Mass., 1669; styled capt.; freeman, 1683; his sister, Magdaline, lived with him and bro. John in Marblehead; the town records state: "Robert and John Bartlett were of the original commoners, their names being recorded in the list prepared by order of the General Court of Mass., in 1674, and confirmed in their rights and privileges therein"; Robert was a proprietor of Dunstable, Mass.; m. bef. 1669, Mary, dau. of Rev. William Walton of Marblehead; m. 2d. Dec. 24. 1702. Rebecca (Boobyer) Pinson

(living 1714), widow of William Pinsent or Pinson; issue (1st marriage): 1-William (eldest s. in 1714-will proved Apr. 14, 1735), husbandman and fisherman, Marblehead; m. Dec. 27, 1688, Sarah Purchase (living 1735); 2-Nathaniel (estate administered, July 26, 1729); of Marblehead; m. bef. 1698, Rebecca —; 3-Martha, m. Oct. 10, 1700, Robert Nicholson, Jr., of Marblehead; 4-John (estate administered, Dec. 30, 1762), m. Marblehead, Nov. 29, 1705, Remember Owens; 5-Josiah (bap. Sept. 21, 1684-will proved July 12, 1744), m. Nov. 28, 1706, Obedience Merritt (d. bef. 1756); 6-Abigail (bap. Sept. 11, 1687), m. Dec. 11, 1707, Thomas (bap. July 12, 1685-living 1746), son of John Bartoll, mariner of Marblehead (see B424-C1126a-E359-E378-G164-N146w).

In the Name of God Amen I Robert Nicholson of Marblehead in the County of Essex Shoresman do hereby make my last will and Testament I resign my soul to God and my body to the ground to be buried at the discretion of my Executors I will that my debts and several charges shall be paid by my Executors I give to my son Josiah if he be living) my four Lsape in the upper Division of the Common Lands of Marblehead to him his heirs and assigns forever and if my said son be not living then I give the said Lsape to his children their heirs and assigns forever to be equally divided between them

I give to my son Josiah his share of my Lsape forever all my two dwelling houses & barn situate in said Marblehead with my Land thereto adjoining, also my gun & sword and one of my beds to which he shall choose he purvey to my Daughters the several Legacies herein aftermentioned Appointed to be paid to my Daughters by my Executors

I give to my Daughter Martha Dodd sixty pounds and Tenor Bills of Credit to be paid by my Executors within Twelve months next after my Decease

I give to my Daughter Mary the wife of Thomas Brown forty pounds and Tenor Bills of Credit to be paid within one year after my Decease by my Executors

I give to my Daughter Abigail the wife of Joseph Davis my other Treasures Bed and Tuffey Bounidin and Tenor Bills of Credit to be paid her within one year after my Decease by my Executors

I give to my Daughters Martha Mary and Abigail to be equally divided between them

Finally I hereby constitute and Appoint my said son Josiah and my wellbeloved friend Joseph Ricket of said Marblehead Shoresman the Executors of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all Wills by me heretofore made In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and Seal this Thirtieth Day of March in the Year of our Lord sevenhundred forty eight
